Currently on there are galleries of photographs of

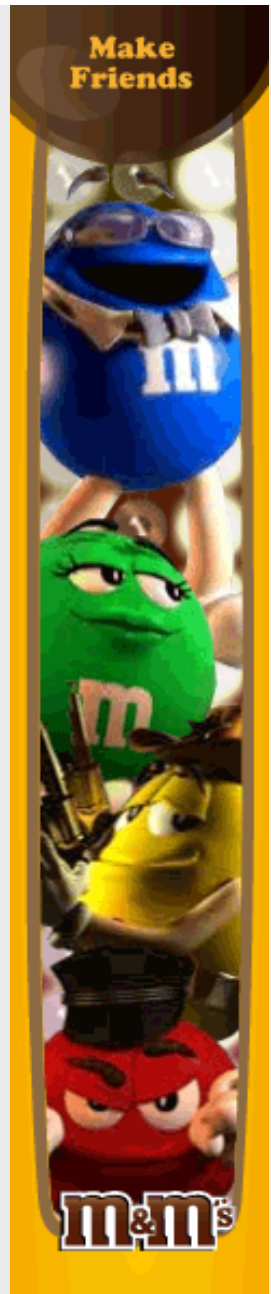
- the Chicago [Before the Holidays Party](#)
